A Ladies vs. Lust Opportunity Reality Check



The Usual Question: "What am I getting?" **vs** The Real Question: "What does he expect to get?"

THE OFFER: What am I actually being offered?

Money? Access? Introduction? Mentorship? Contract? Visibility Information? Opportunity?

THE ASK: What am I actually being asked to give?

Time? Expertise? Labor? Personal information? Availability? Social access? Emotional support? Romantic/sexual attention? Something that wasn't part of the original agreement?

THE COST: What am I being asked to give up in order to keep this opportunity?

Time, Privacy, Boundaries, Comfort, Reputation? Peace?

THE EXTRA: What has been added that wasn't part of the original professional exchange?

THE CONDITION: Has anything about the opportunity changed because I didn't reciprocate something personal?

THE NO TEST: If I said no to the personal part, would the professional opportunity still exist?

THE EXCHANGE CHECK

- What I came for
- What I was offered
- What I was asked for
- What changed
- What I actually agreed to
- What I am not agreeing to

An opportunity isn't automatically transactional just because someone is interested in you.
However, you are allowed to examine the transaction when the terms start changing.
